**Forgiveness–Human vs. Divine By Ted Kober:** Distinguishing biblical from human forgiveness:

Misconceptions about biblical

Reconciliation forgiveness often evolve from human practices. Note these differences: Forgiveness is simply excusing. Phrases such as "That's okay" or "No problem" minimize sin. To unbelievers, it may seem that forgiveness is just another way to excuse an offense. My sins are not excused. God's justice required blood. "Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins" (Hebrews 9:22). But shedding my blood would be futile. God provided the perfect sacrifice.
