The belief that true love means total acceptance of all beliefs and lifestyles.

- 1 John 4:10 Loved is defined by Christ's sacrifice.
- John 4:1-26 Loved displayed to the Samaritan woman.
- John 8:1-11- Love displayed to adulterous woman.
- Ephesians 4:15- Speak the truth in love.
- James 5:19-20 Restoring a sinner saves them.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:4- We aim to please God, not men.

The belief that true freedom is the absence of constraint in order to pursue internal desires.

- Isaiah 61:1 + Luke 4:18- Christ came to set us free.
- John 8:31-36- We have freedom from sin which enslaves.
- Romans 6:16-18- We are free from sin but slaves to righteousness.
- Galatians 5:13-14- Don't use freedom as opportunity for the flesh.
- I Corinthians 6:12- Not all is wise because sin dominates.
- 1 Peter 2:16-17- Our freedom doesn't cover-up evil.

- Romans 3:10-12,23- None are righteous and all have sinned.
- Matthew 16:27 + Romans 2:6 Each will be judged according to their actions.
- Mark 7:8- Don't add human traditions to the Word.
- 1 Corinthians 4:6- Don't go beyond what's written.
- Ephesians 2:11-16- Christ breaks down hostility between people groups.
- Matthew 22:37-40, I John 4:20- Love of God and others are synonymous.
- Philippians 4:2-3- Women referred to as Paul's fellow workers.
- James 2:17-18 Faith should produce genuine action.
