

## Women's Ministry Monthly Schedule:

### September 9: Identity in Christ: Embracing Your Worth as Daughters of God

**Topical Question:** How can understanding our identity in Christ impact the way we view ourselves and interact with the world?

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me, and the life I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

### October 14: Sisterhood and Support: Building Strong Relationships Among Women

**Topical Question:** What are some practical ways we can support and uplift each other in our faith journeys and daily lives as daughters, in-laws, co-workers, neighbors and friends?

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 "Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up!"

### November 11: Balancing Faith, Family, and Career as Christian Women, especially during the Holidays

**Topical Question:** How can we find a healthy balance between our roles as Christian women, whether in our families, careers, or communities, especially during the hectic holidays?

Proverbs 31:25 "Strength and dignity are her clothing, and she laughs at the time to come."

### December 9: Cultivating Inner Beauty: Godly Perspectives on Self-Care

**Topical Question:** How can we practice self-care in ways that honor God and nurture our inner beauty and well-being?

1 Peter 3:3-4 "Do not let your adorning be external—the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear— but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious."

### January 13: Praying with Purpose: Deepening Your Connection with God

**Topical Question:** What strategies can we employ to enhance our prayer lives and strengthen our relationship with God?

Philippians 4:6-7 "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

### February 10: Healthy Boundaries and Relationships: Navigating Romance, Female Friendships and More

**Topical Question:** How can we establish and maintain healthy boundaries in our relationships, while still showing Christ-like love?

Proverbs 4:23 "Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life."

### **March 9: Overcoming Insecurities: Finding Confidence in God's Love**

**Topical Question:** In what ways does understanding God's unconditional love help us overcome our insecurities and find lasting confidence?

Romans 8:38-39 "For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

### **April 13: Strengthening Your Gifts: Serving God and Others with Your Talents**

**Topical Question:** How can we identify and utilize our unique gifts and talents to serve God and make a positive impact on those around us?

1 Peter 4:10 "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace."

### **May 11: Seasons of Life: Contentment and Preparation in Singleness, Marriage and Parenting.**

**Topical Question:** How can we find contentment in our single season while actively preparing ourselves for future relationships or endeavors?

Scripture: Psalm 46:10 "Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!"

### **June 8: Authentic Purity: Embracing God's Design for Physical and Emotional Well-being**

**Topical Question:** How can we embrace a lifestyle of authentic purity in both our physical and emotional aspects, guided by God's design?

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 "Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body."

### **July 13: Empowered to Lead: Women's Role in Ministry and Community**

**Topical Question:** What are some ways women can exercise leadership within the church and community while staying faithful to biblical principles?

Esther 4:14b "And who knows whether you have not come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"

### **August 10: Celebrating God's Faithfulness: Sharing Stories of Transformation and Growth**

**Topical Question:** How have you personally experienced God's faithfulness and transformation in your journey as a Christian woman?

Psalm 107:2 "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he has redeemed from trouble."
