Into the Bible

Read Acts 13:1-3

- 2. It is fitting that this passage falls during the week of fasting and prayer at Calvary Chapel Meridian. In this passage we see the Holy Spirit gave direction to the church as they fasted and prayed. What does this teach us about the need for the believers in our church to be praying for God's leading in the church?
- 3. The Holy Spirit instructed the church, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." The Bible teaches us that we have been "created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them (Ephesians 2:10)." As you consider the word "separate," what might God be encouraging us to release, adjust, or reprioritize so that we are more available for the work He has called us to do?

- 4. Paul and Barnabas began to travel and bring the gospel to each city they visited. Not surprisingly, they soon experienced opposition. What do the following verses teach us about what we should expect from the world as we serve Jesus and how can we stay strong in the face of opposition?
