Galatians 6:1-10

Get to Know Me

1. What are some of the ways that you seek to support other Christians around you?

Into the Bible

Read Galatians 6:1

2. The idea of the word that is translated “overtaken” describes someone who has *fallen* into a sinful situation. It is not describing someone who is rebellious and obstinate. We are called to restore the one who has *fallen* into sin. Why might it be easier to restore this kind of person than a rebellious person? And what are some steps that we could take to help restore someone who has fallen into sin?
3. What are the attitudes that we must have when helping to restore a sinning brother or sister and why are they important to the work of restoring others?

Read Galatians 6:2

4. Read the following verses and discuss what it means to “bear one another’s burdens” to fulfill the “law of Christ.”
 - a. John 13:34
 - b. Matthew 22:37-40

Read Galatians 6:3-5

5. Verse three warns against the self-deceptive power of pride. How can pride cause us to deceive ourselves?
6. One of the temptations that come with ministering to someone who has fallen into sin is to feel superior or more righteous. How can “examining” our own works or checking our motivations help us maintain the proper attitude of humility when dealing with such a person?



Read Galatians 6:6-8

7. These verses are about being *participants* of the church, not merely *takers* in the church. While investing financially in the work of the church is suggested here, being a *participant* means more than just financial support. The context is obviously suggesting that we would partner in other ways as well. What are some of the additional ways that we can partner with those who teach us the word and minister to the church body?

Read Galatians 6:9-10

8. The word “good” means, *beautiful; praiseworthy*. What is being commanded in these verses and what is meant by, “as we have opportunity”?

9. What steps can you take to be more *invested* in your role as a member of the body of Christ?
