Responsibilities:

- Meets weekly with the AC Kids Director to ensure AC Kids is running smoothly and living out the four core values.
- Attends staff meetings and other required collaborative meetings with fellow ministry leads.
- Connects with the Director of Facilities for space management, repairs & improvements.
- Supports the AC Kids Director in developing leaders within AC Kids.
- Takes part in the execution of onboarding and training of Crew members.
- Works with AC Kids Director in leading and organizing AC Kids training and event meetings.
- Maintains and troubleshoots the electronic check-in system and updates processes as needed.
- Leads the Weekly Task Team to ensure the AC Kids space is ready for Sunday mornings.
- Manages all ordering/purchasing of classroom materials/supplies, equipment, gifting.
- Oversees all digital elements & software within AC Kids. (Toddler Upper Elementary)
- Leads the Sunday morning Kids Experience as Point Person.
- Builds relationships with the AC Kids Crew, while offering feedback and areas of improvement.
- Organizes and oversees all babysitting needed for groups and special events.
- Works alongside the AC Kids Director to execute family events and outreach (VBS, Parent's Night Out, Baby Dedication, Alltober Fest).
- Supports in the planning and purchasing for AC Kids specific events and holidays.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as assigned to support the overall mission and operations of the church.
