Stop by the Host Team tent today after our worship assembly. We'd love to meet you!

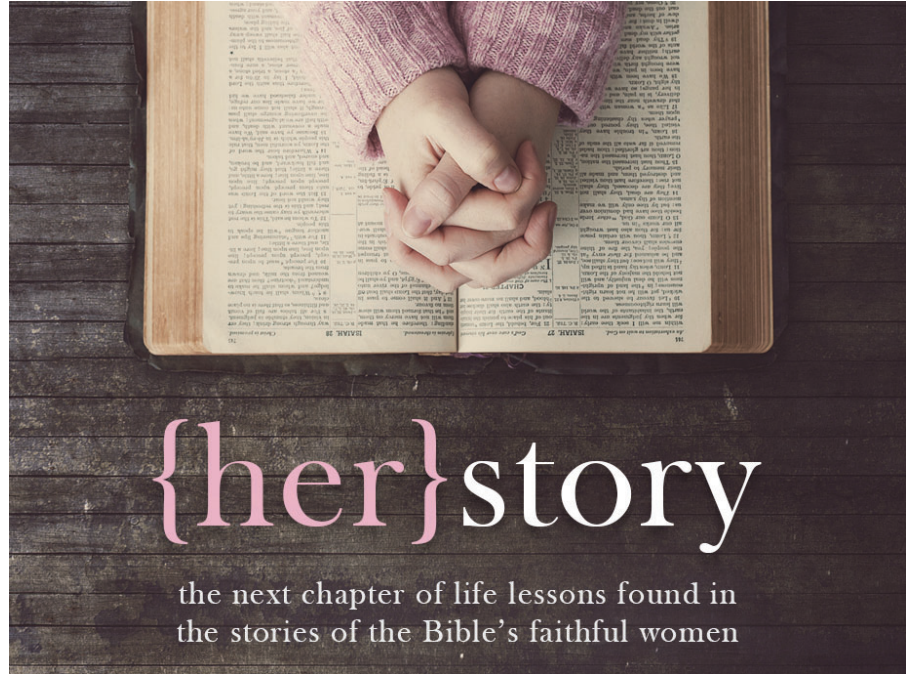
WELCOME!
