
Hello, GC Family!

As we wrap up this series, I want to make sure we don't forget just how good the good news is. Today we will work through all of Romans 8. To me, this is one of the most powerful chapters in the entire Bible. We get a glimpse of just how the apostle Paul felt about the goodness of the good news. It is my prayer that we can receive the gospel with the same excitement he did. Here are just a few of his words...

Romans 8:

- 1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you free from the law of sin and death. 3 For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in the flesh, 4 in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
- 37 In all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.
 38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, 39 neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
