This week we shared two exciting pieces of news with our church family. In case you missed it, I want to give you a chance to see it too.

First, we are excited to announce that we are beginning the process to once again add to our staff. This past October, one of our staff members, Huston Oliver, began a new ministry. At the time of his departure we decided to evaluate our needs for a season before beginning a process of hiring a new team member. After several months of prayer and deliberation, we have decided that it is time to begin the search for a Discipleship Minister at GCI With this hire we will add someone to the team that will oversee organized groups ministries, as well as the process that leads to organic discipleship groups.

Second, we are extremely encouraged by the news on the national, state, and local level about the progress being made against COVID-19. As of this week, the case count in Forsyth County has reached a threshold that will allow us to make the first of several incremental changes to our policy. Beginning this Sunday, we will ask attendees at both services to wear masks while entering, moving through, or exiting the facility. Once seated in the auditorium, wearing a mask will be optional. We will continue to evaluate, and hope to make additional changes as appropriate.

I'm personally very grateful to God for the progress that continues to be made, and want to acknowledge that.
