Hello, GC Family!

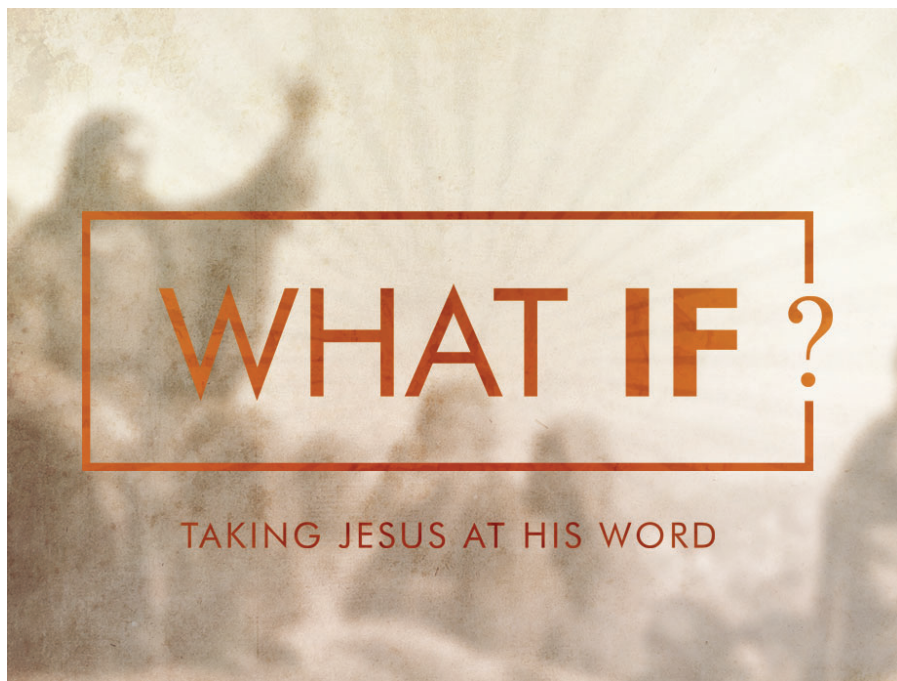

PRAYER SPOTLIGHT

(Psalm 94 says the wicked are proud and arrogant; they say, "The Lord does not see" (v:7). Conversely, "The Lord knows the thoughts of man" (v:11).)

Dear Father, we know that you discipline nations (v:10) for their wickedness, but we also know that "Blessed is the man who is disciplined" (v:12), because you, O Father, discipline those you love. We know too that you discipline us for our good (Heb.12:6,10), and for that we are truly blessed when we see the error of our ways and can turn back to the right way. "When I said, 'My foot is slipping,' your love, O Lord, supported me.
