

The words of scripture discuss the qualities desirable in men who will serve this way in a few specific passages: 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, 1 Peter 5:1-4. I encourage you to read these verses and spend time in prayer asking that God might lead you as you think through those who may be qualified.

We are extending the invitation to make up to **five nominations** to any person who considers Grace Chapel their church home. Here's how you can make a nomination:

- 1. Pick up a **nomination card** at the Connection Desk and turn it in, completed, to any current elder by 2-6-2022, or,
- 2. Send an email to the elders at **elders@ gracechapelchurch.com** by 2-6-2022.

Once all nominations have been collected, the current elder group will take time to review and pray over those who have been nominated. Whether you choose to be a part of the nomination process or not, we invite you to be in prayer over the next several weeks as we ask God to lead us to additional shepherds over the GC family
