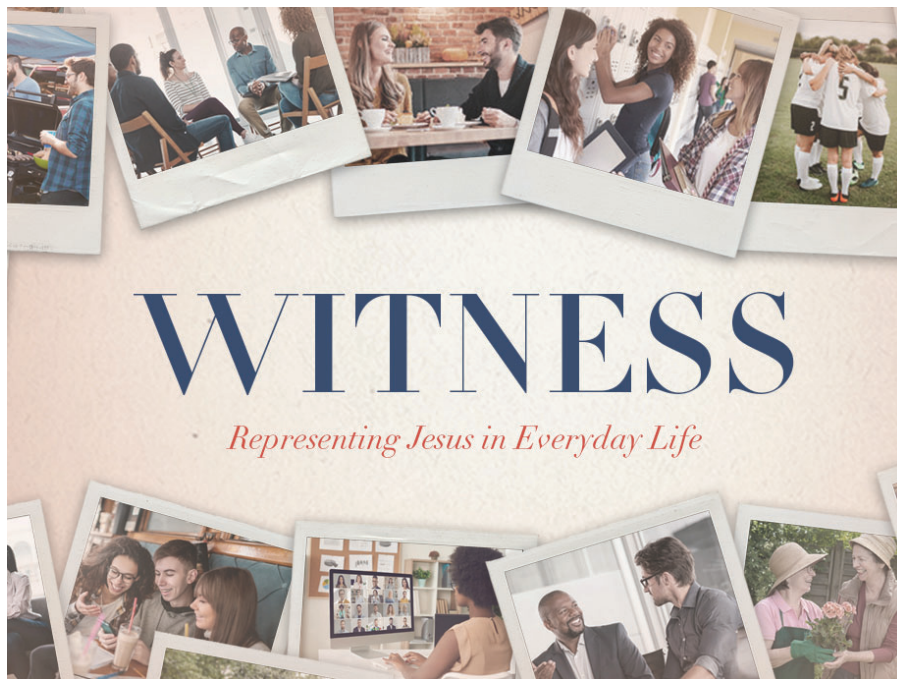
Good morning, Grace Chapel Family!

With so many in our culture moving to a place of general mistrust of the Church and individual Christians, many wonder what can be done. I think Jesus has the answer for us in Matthew 5:

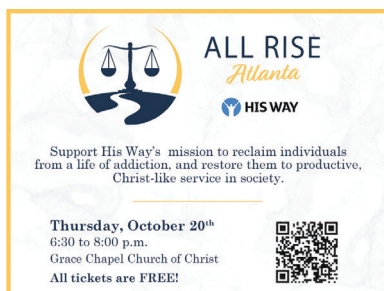
