Last week, as we began a new and different kind of series, I shared a verse ,which I believe that all who make disciples who make disciples, hold dear. The words of this verse express a faith, not in the power of our words as we seek to help lead others to faith in God, but faith in the word of God—the words of the Bible as inspired by the Holy Spirit.

Here's what I hold to be true, taken directly from Hebrews 4:12 (NIV):

"For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart."
