My friend and Renew's chief editor, Daniel McCoy, wrote a great article I'd like to share with you.

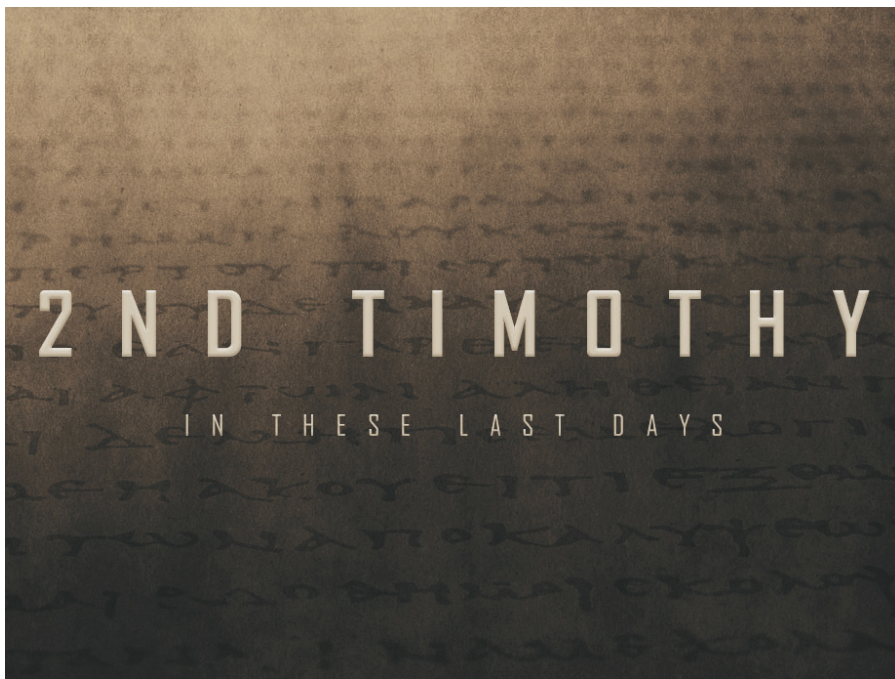
