Last week I shared that several years ago I served a church for nine months as their interim minister. During that time there were two common comments sent my way: one was that it was a time for grieving, and the other was that it was a time for healing.

The happier side of this is connected to grieving. When done correctly, grieving ends with a sense of healing.

The other side is healing as recovery from hurt. The sad reality is that ministers hurt people. Sometimes it is intentional; most times (I hope), it is inadvertent. In many cases the minister never knows they hurt you.

Here are ways you may have been hurt by a church or a minister:

- You were overlooked. Even though you were the perfect person for the job, they asked someone else to lead.
- 2. Your idea wasn't adopted. Either you pitched an idea that was great but ignored, or you lobbied that the church go one way and they chose the other—your idea got snubbed, and that hurts.
- 3. You were underappreciated. You worked hard for years and did a good job. Your participation was vital to the church's success, yet you felt taken for granted more than appreciated.
- 4. They offended you. A sermon, an article or social media post...maybe a new church policy—it felt too personal and hurt your feelings.

You get the idea. If you were hurt, you know it and you know why.

Now is a time to let go of any bitterness or harbored resentment and move on.
