THIS OR THAT: An adult makes about 35,000 choices every day, but adults are not the only ones with choices to make. Children have their fair share of choices too—about 3,500 of them. Every. Single.

Day. Knowing that our preschooler's 3,500 daily choices will one day turn into 35,000 daily choices is why we want to teach preschoolers that when they have a choice between This or That, they can trust that God knows what's best for them.

REMEMBER THIS: "God...knows everything." (1 John 3:20, NIV)
