Next month we will have nearly a church-wide focus on mental health. The collection of sermons for October and November will be called "Peace! Be Still!" and will attempt to give us Biblical practices that will uphold healthy minds. Small group curriculum is being developed and will be distributed for any of our adult small groups who are interested in going deeper in the subject matter. The youth group will have a similarly themed series being taught on Sunday nights that will focus on hope in a world that offers very little.

Additionally, we will host Trusted Sources, a local non-profit aiming to help families have better conversations about mental health, as well as helping families do better at finding help. Sunday, October 1st, they will take over our Youth Night and run a program designed to connect with teenagers and get them comfortable talking about some of these issues. The following Sunday evening, beginning at 4:30 p.m., they will host a bridge event that targets the parents and grandparents of those teens to empower and equip them to handle some of these more difficult situations.

Everything we will be doing will come from a Christian point of view. I am confident that these are issues and topics that your non-Christian friends and neighbors and co-workers and family members care about.
