PRAYER SPOTLIGHT

In Psalm 23:2, shepherds lead their sheep to the lush meadows of good grass. "Still waters" (sheep are very skittish; noise of rushing water frightens them) are analogous to Jesus' words that our food is the word of God (Matthew 4:4). He told the Samaritan that he had water that springs up to eternal life (John 4:14). These are overtones of spiritual nourishment that God provides to those who follow, i.e. "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life..." (John 10:27).

Dear God, Shepherd of my soul, your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. You bring meaning and purpose to the lives of those who follow your lead. Thank you for the gracious hope your promises guarantee to those redeemed in Christ. May we always be the sheep of your pasture. Amen.
