

Global Engagement: When we Give, We Go Pastor James Heyward

When you give, you do not just give to the church—you go with the gospel, you send workers, and you help gather the nations to Jesus.

When you give, you go.

Go - The call to all nations.

Read Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8 and Genesis 12:1-3.

- 1. According to these verses, what is the call?
- 2. Who is being called?
- 3. Has God called you to go somewhere or to someone? What was your response?

Send - Praying for and releasing workers.

Read Matthew 9:37-38, Luke 10:1-2 and Romans 10:13-15.

- 4. What is the condition of the harvest?
- 5. Why do you think the workers are few?

- 6. What can you do to be involved in sending workers into the harvest?
- 7. Could you be the answer to your own prayers?

Support - Generous partnership in the gospel. Read Luke 8:1-3, 1 Corinthians 9:7-14, and Philippians 4:14-19.

- 8. According to these verses, who financially supported Jesus and His disciples as they ministered?
- 9. What principles about supporting those who bring the gospel are recorded in 1 Corinthians 9?
- 10. When you give, you are not a donor; you are a partner in the harvest. How will you become a partner in the harvest?

Gathered - God's end vision; all the nations gathered. Read Psalm 67:1-7, Isaiah 49:6, and Revelation 7:9-10.

- 11. There will be no gathering without giving, sending, and going. Pray that the Holy Spirit speaks to you about your part in giving, in sending, and in going.
- 12. Share with someone what the Holy Spirit speaks to you and what you are going to do about it.
