The most important question of Revelation is not the what, the where, or the how; the most important question is the who. The who of Revelation is Jesus.

A. Jesus is the First and the Final

"Yes, I'm on my way! I'll be there soon! I'm bringing my payroll with me. I'll pay all people in full for their life's work. I'm A to Z, the **First and the Final**, Beginning and Conclusion." Revelation 22:12-13 (Message)

- Wash your Robes
 "How blessed are those who wash their robes! The Tree of Life is theirs for good, and they'll walk through the gates to the City. But outside for good are the filthy curs: sorcerers, fornicators, murderers, idolaters—all who love and live lies."

 Revelation 22:14-15 (Message)
- 7. Our robes are washed in the blood of the Lamb; the blood of the Lamb covers us in His righteousness. Why is it important for you to wash your robes?
- Worship God "I, John, saw all these things with my own eyes, heard them with my ears. Immediately when I heard and saw, I fell on my face to worship at the feet of the Angel who laid it all out before me. He objected, "No you don't! I'm a servant just like you and your companions, the prophets, and all who keep the words of this book. Worship God!" Revelation 22:8-9 (Message)
