# Community Bible Church Discipleship Challenge

2026



#### How it Works

The Discipleship Challenge invites participants to deepen their engagement with Scripture by reading selected books of the Bible, memorizing one key verse from each, and giving a brief summary of what they've read. Participants choose their own track, ranging from a few books to the entire Bible, and may complete the challenge at any pace throughout 2026. Everyone who finishes any track will be recognized.

There is no required reading schedule—participants may use a structured plan like the Navigators Bible Reading Plan or set their own pace, even reading freely without a formal plan. Short summaries of books are provided, which can be shared in your own words and confirmed by anyone. The challenge is open to everyone—individuals, families, and groups of all ages—and any Bible translation may be used.

This booklet contains every book of the Bible broken into tracks (Law, History, etc.). Each book has a checkbox for every chapter and the key verse to memorize. Bible Summaries can be found at cbcomaha.org/challenge
