Join us as we study the Gospel of John, one of the four accounts of Jesus' life and ministry in the New Testament. John focuses on who Jesus is—the Son of God—and why believing in Him leads to eternal life.

Over the course of this study, we will:

- Read through the entire Gospel of John together
- Discuss its major themes, including belief, eternal life, truth, and discipleship
- Explore how John's account applies to daily life as men seeking to follow Christ

This study is open to men of all ages and levels of Bible knowledge. Bring a Bible and be ready to learn, ask questions, and engage in discussion.
