

FOR YOUR SAFETY

It is the desire of Community Bible Church for each individual and each family to experience the highest level of safety when attending our church. We believe safety and personal responsibility do not have to be sacrificed when entrusting our lives to the sovereignty of God.

For example, just as we trust God to protect us, we still lock our doors at home and in our cars. The bricks and mortar that make up a church building are not somehow exempt from those seeking to do harm. We believe it is up to each individual place of worship to uphold the value of stewardship by assuming the appropriate level of responsibility to protect its people, facility, sensitive information and other assets. We believe this goes back to the truths found in many passages in scripture, particularly in Romans 13.

One way we can do this is to have a strong relationship with our local first responders. This allows us to consult with them on the best practices and procedures for our location.

Another way we provide security is to provide the church with safety team personnel who carry concealed weapons. This is a legal way for the church to provide a very high level of risk management for the people in our building. In the event of certain incidents, this allows us to have a quick response to a threat. Our safety team personnel are also trained in basic first aid, CPR, use of the AED and are prepared for inclement weather and fire emergencies.

These individuals are specifically selected and approved by church leadership. The individuals who participate in this program are trained and dedicated to the safety of others.



We do not claim to know all the answers or why bad things happen, however, we always trust God first and foremost and know that He alone is the one who protects us. With these truths in mind, we will continue to trust God as well as provide the very best safety measures we can.
