


Questions for Personal Reflection or Group Discussion

- 5. How does this moment reveal David's humanity and weakness—even as a man after God's own heart?
- 6. How does Abigail model godly wisdom, humility, and courage?
- 7. How can we learn to pause and seek God before reacting in anger?






