



## SERIES OVERVIEW

**Tagline:** Escape to New Life!

**Synopsis:** Earth was the ultimate escape room, a place where all God's people were doomed to die from sin. Then God sent us a hero, a Savior, who would show us the way out. The story of Jesus' death and resurrection is the ultimate escape story. If we follow the way Jesus has made for us, we can escape to new life.

**Objective:** Kids will learn how Jesus made a way for us to escape the price of sin.

**Memory Verse:** "So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." John 8:36 (NIV)

### Solve the Riddles

**Scripture:** Isaiah 53, Jesus' Death Predicted

Every escape room is filled with clues, puzzles, and riddles that need to be solved. For centuries God had given clues to the prophets about how He would one day help us escape from sin. All of these clues point to the death and resurrection of Jesus.

**Objective:** Kids will learn that Bible prophesied that Jesus would come to save us from sin.

### Stick Together

**Scripture:** Mark 14:43-50, Mark 15:6-15, The Disciples Flee and the Crowds Say Crucify

In an escape room, everyone must work together or there is no hope of escape! The disciples abandoned Jesus in His moment of greatest need, and the crowds turned on Jesus. In spite of all this, Jesus still fulfilled His mission and made a way for our escape.

**Objective:** Kids will say they must choose to stick with Jesus.

### Doomed!

**Scripture:** Mark 15:21-47, The Crucifixion

A truly great escape room can really give you a sense of being trapped, even though it's not real. All truly seemed lost when Jesus was sentenced to die on the cross, but not even death could stop Jesus!

**Objective:** Kids will say that Jesus died for their sins.

### Free!

**Scripture:** Mark 16:1-8, Jesus is Alive

Of all the dramatic escapes in history, none can match the drama of Jesus escaping from the tomb. If we place our faith in Jesus, we can escape sin and live a new life.

**Objective:** Kids will say that if they trust in Jesus, they can escape the punishment of sin.
