


## **CHAPTER 19:1-10**

- Focus of this passage: the Marriage Supper of the Lamb and the rewards for each believer occurs in the context of the 2<sup>nd</sup> coming and the rapture. (19:7-10)
- Multitudes of saints, 24 elders, and 4 living creatures all fall down and worship God, i.e. they agree with His judgments. (19:1-3)
- The multitudes' voice is the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings. (19:6)

The marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready!! (19:7)



"And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God."

(Revelation 19:9)

## THE JEWISH WEDDING

- The *ketubah* the betrothal the unilateral agreement of how the husband will provide and care for the wife
  - payment of purchase price (1 Cor.11:25, 6:19-20)
  - Bride set apart sanctified (Eph.5:25-27; 1 Cor.1:2, 6:11; Heb.10:10, 13:12)
- Bridegroom departs to the Father's House the bridegroom prepares room addition (Jn.14:2-3) while bride prepares for his imminent return
- Surprise appearance/return when Father says 'go'/gathering together of all who are invited (Matt.25:1-13; 1 Thess.4:16-17) -Huppah, wedding ceremony
- Seven-day Marriage celebration/supper

## CHAPTER 19:1-10 MARRIAGE SUPPER OF THE LAMB



## 5<sup>TH</sup> CHRONOLOGICAL SECTION: JESUS' TRIUMPHAL ENTRY 19:11-21:8

- 5<sup>th</sup> Chronologic section is the high point of human history:
- Jesus comes to Jerusalem as our Bridegroom-King-Judge to end the Armageddon campaign by defeating the Antichrist, and to establish His earthly 1000-yr millennial kingdom [which then prepares the earth to receive the Father's throne (Rev. 21:3)]
- The final stage of Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> coming procession is the climax of His return.
- Jesus makes His triumphal entry into Jerusalem in the context of history's greatest military conflict.
- He will deliver Israel at the Mount of Olives and be welcomed and received by Israel's leaders (Matt.23:39, Zech.14:4)

## 5<sup>TH</sup> CHRONOLOGICAL SECTION: JESUS' TRIUMPHAL ENTRY 19:11-21:8

Jesus will only come back in response to the prayers of the saints, who will be engaged in the greatest justice movement in history.

The 24/7 prayers of the saints worldwide (Lk.18:7-8; Is.42:10-16; Rev.5:8, 22:17) will join with the prayers of the *remnant of Israel* (Zech.12:10; Is.64:1-12, 30:18-33; Ps.94:1-23, 98:1-9, 99:1-9, etc.) and of the martyrs in heaven (Rev.6:10).

#### **SUMMARY:**

The most dramatic events in world history will occur in the context of the greatest military campaign, undergirded by the greatest prayer movement, contending against the greatest oppression, to see the greatest justice movement fulfilled across the whole earth.

## 7 SCENES IN REV. 19:11-21:8



- Scene 1, 19:11-16 Jesus presents Himself as He approaches Jerusalem for the final battle
- Scene 2, 19:17-21 Jesus defeats the Antichrist at the Battle of Jerusalem
- Scene 3, 20:1-3 Satan is cast into prison for 1000 years
- Scene 4, 20:4-6 Saints are given the governmental leadership over the earth
- Scene 5, 20:7-10 Satan is released after 1000 years, giving all a final choice to obey
- Scene 6, 20:11-15 Great White Throne: God's final judgment of all enemies
- Scene 7, 21:1-8 The Father establishes His Throne with His people on earth

# Jesus presents Himself as He approaches Jerusalem for the final battle (19:11-16)

- Faithful and True all His promises are reliable and all His polices are free of deception
- Robe dipped in blood most scholars see this as the blood of Jesus' enemies. The eschatological winepress is the gathering of evil leaders to Jerusalem, and the wine flowing out is their blood. The blood on His robe denotes His personal involvement and public statement that He believes in this war. (Ps. 110:5-6)
- Armies follow Him Jesus conquers in partnership with His people (Rev.3:21; Jn.17:24). The saints are with Him (1 Thess.4:14, Zech.14:5). The saints dash the nations with Him (Rev. 2:27).

## SCENE 1



## Jesus defeats the Antichrist at the Battle of Jerusalem (Rev.19:17-21)

- Nations gather to make war (Rev.17:14, 19:19), who they believe is a false messiah or angel of light (2 Cor.11:14). (Islamic traditions say that Prophet Jesus, will return and will join forces with the Islamic messiah, the Mahdi, in a battle against a false messiah.) Satan deceives the kings into coming (Rev.16:13-16) and the Lord gathers them into His winepress in Jerusalem to kill them (Joel 3:2, 11-21).
- Jesus great victory at the Battle of Jerusalem which the OT prophets prophesied (Zech.12:3 and 14:2-5...note this is NOT in the Jezreel Valley near Megiddo). Jesus splits the Mount of Olives, arriving at the perfect time to rescue the remnant of Israel.
- The pinnacle of His 2<sup>nd</sup> coming is Jesus' reentry into the city of Jerusalem to be officially received and celebrated by the governmental leaders of Israel as their Messiah (Mt.23:3), the Son of David and their King.





### THE MILLENNIUM

- Creation is changed:

   -physical changes Zech 14:9-10
   (incl. Jerus. raised up); Is.35:1-10
   -curse lifted Is.11:6-9
- Yet, it's not eternity: Is.65
  -death, sin Is.65:20 100 yrs is young
  -each to have land Is.65:21
  -Fruitful Amos 9:13
- Lifespans are long, and death is for unbelievers only(?): Is.65:22 (lifetime of a tree) -nowhere is there mentioned a resurrection of Millennial saints...



## What is Life during the Millennium?


- During the Millennium, the saints will reign under the regency of Christ and He shall rule with an **iron** rod.
- Throughout the earth, there will be great love for Jesus, for His wonderful compassion and benevolence.
- God will not remove free will, those with physical bodies will still sin.
- Those born during the Millennium will still have to come in faith to Jesus Christ
- People from all nations will flock to Jerusalem to worship Jesus Christ and seek counsel.

- Sacrifices restored (?) Possibly in remembrance, memorials?)- for both Jews and Gentiles (Is.56:7; 66:20-23, Jer. 33:18; Ez.45:13-17; Mal.3:3-4)
- Any nation that doesn't come for Feast of Tabernacles will be **denied rain**. (Zech.14:16-18)
- Similar to Solomons Temple -only MUCH larger -has singers chambers, priests and peoples kitchens, inner and outer gates, many chambers
- ITS NOT on the "Temple Mount" its to the north in a large "Holy District"- north of the city of Jerusalem (Eze.45)
- Water comes from the temple flows to Jerusalem, then splits off east to the 'no-longer-dead' sea and west to the Mediterranean sea.
- Land is granted to all the 12 tribes including Levi
- It is only open on Shabbat and New Moon (Eze.46:1)
- What it doesn't have: women's court, laver, table of shewbread, lampstand/menorah, altar of incense, no veil between sections, no ark of the covenant.

## SCENE 3

## At the beginning, Satan is cast into prison for 1000 years (20:1-3)

- Bound with supernatural chains he will be cast into the pit/prison and shut up without communication or activity on the earth, and a seal set on him to keep him there.
- Here we see <u>four names</u> of Satan: (each depicts crimes and reveals ways in which he attacks us)

Dragon – denotes his cruelty

Serpent of Old – refers to liar in the

Garden (Gen. 3)

Devil – means the accuser

Satan – means the adversary



## Saints are given governmental leadership over the earth (20:4-6)

- John saw **thrones** as one of the highlights in Revelation.
- The saints (Rev. 19:14,19) are the subject of the phrase "they sat" (20:4) "given authority to judge". Jesus will govern the earth in partnership with resurrected saints.
- All governmental authority will be replaced and put in the hands of those who exhibited meekness on the earth (Mt.5:5),
- Jesus will rule a worldwide kingdom in partnership with 2 types of kings:
   kings of the earth (non-resurrected bodies) and resurrected kings with incorruptible bodies.

## **SCENE 4**



## Satan is released after 1000 years, & given a final choice to obey (20:7-10)

- Satan must be released at the end of the millennium – Why???
- God will openly manifest the truth about the depth
  of human sin (i.e. the mystery of lawlessness in 2
  Thess.2:7), and about Satan being incurably evil.
- Satan deceives the nations revealing he was not rehabilitated or changed.
- God demonstrates the justice of his eternal
  judgments by showing that some men rebel
  even in an ideal environment, because they love
  sin. Men will not be able to blame their sin on
  difficult circumstances.


The Great White Throne: God's final judgment of all enemies (20:11-15)

This is the second death...








## IN CONTRAST- IT'S THE BEMA SEAT FOR US

- In the Greek, a single word is used for "judgment seat" in Romans 14:10 and 2 Corinthians 5:10—the word is bema. A bema was a raised platform on which judges sat to view athletic games.
- Their job was to make sure contestants followed the rules and to present awards to the victors (see 1 Cor. 9:24–27). The bema was never a place to reprimand the athletes or to punish them in any way. It was a place of testing and reward.
- In the same way, the bema of Christ will not be a place of condemnation or censure.




## CHAPTER 20 -MILLENNIAL REIGN - FINAL JUDGMENTS



## DOCTRINE OF ETERNAL PUNISHMENT

**ANNIHILATIONISM** 

Annihilationism is the teaching that the unsaved, after death, will eventually be annihilated - the souls of the wicked will be snuffed out of existence rather than be sent to an everlasting, conscious hell. This doctrine is taught in cultic or quasi-cultic groups such as the Jehovah's Witnesses and The 7th Day Adventists. This doctrine is contradicted by the Bible in Matt. 25:46 which says "..these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal." Jesus repeatedly called hell a place of unquenchable fire (Mark 9:43-48) where their worm dieth not. John the apostle described hell or the lake of fire as a place of eternal torment. Revelation 14:9-12 reads "...the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God...and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone.. in the presence of the Lamb: And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name." He also wrote that "the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever" (Rev. 20:10). Eternal torment indicates that the everlasting state of woe is conscious. The doctrine of annihilation rests more on sentimental than scriptural bases.



The two phrases which are most difficult for annihilationists to explain:

- 1. "the smoke of their torment will rise forever and ever" (from Revelation 14:11)
- 2. "They will be tormented day and night forever and ever" (from Revelation 20:10)

## **SCENE 7 - CH. 21**

# The Father establishes His throne with His people on earth (21:1-8) The high point of all salvation history will be the Father dwelling on earth with humans (vs.3)

- In 21:5-8 The Father gives us a 7-fold message, revealing His commitments to us. **The Father speaks** in a direct way for only the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in Revelation (1:8)
- The New Jerusalem is our eternal dwelling place it descends to the earth on 2 occasions (at the  $2^{nd}$  coming, and then after the Millennial kingdom)
- During the Millennium, Jesus' primary mandate is to prepare the earth for the Father's coming by bringing the nations to mature righteousness (1 Cor.15:24-28). Righteousness will be substantial in the Millennial kingdom then perfect afterwards on the new earth.



## **SCENE 7 - CH. 21**

# The Father establishes His throne with His people on earth (21:1-8) The high point of all salvation history will be the Father dwelling on earth with humans (vs.3)

- All the enemies of Jesus will be subdued during the millennial rebellion. Then the earth will be purged with fire at the end of the Millennium to fully prepare it for the Father (2 Pet.3:1-13; Rev.20:11)
- Fire will 'rinse' and purify the earth, possibly to remove residue resulting from the millennial revolt.
- The adorning of the city as a bride says that God spares no detail or extravagance. City is seen as both the Holy of Holies and the Garden of Eden in Rev.21:9-22:5.
- In 21:3-4 seven negatives are removed: no sea, death, sorrow, crying, pain, curse, and night. All that diminished life will be totally and eternally reversed.



### SCENE 7

# The Father establishes His throne with His people on earth (21:1-8) The high point of all salvation history will be the Father dwelling on earth with humans (vs.3)

- The new earth is the permanent resting place of the New Jerusalem, which will rest forever on the new earth.
- Theologians debate whether this present earth will be renewed or annhiliated after the Millennium to become the new earth.
- The new earth will continue forever
   (Ps.37:29, 78:69, 104:5, 105:10-11, 125:1-2; 1
   Chr.23:25, 28:8; Is.60:21; Ez.37:25; Joel 3:20).
- The words "passed away" in Rev. 21:1 are the same in 2 Cor.5:17.



## CHAPTER 21- NEW HEAVEN/EARTH/JERUSALEM





#### 5<sup>TH</sup> (AND FINAL) ANGELIC EXPLANATION 21:9-22:21 RESTORATION

- OVERVIEW: This angelic explanation describes the dynamic quality of life in the New Jerusalem. Jesus will restore to us all that He originally intended for us when creating the Garden of Eden.
- In Rev. 21-22, God brings the Garden of Eden to replace the Antichrist's empire. Jesus will reverse the tragedy that happened in Eden.
- When the NEW Jerusalem comes to earth, then heaven is literally on earth. It will release a supernatural dimension of resurrection life to the earth (Acts 3:20-21)

#### THE NEW JERUSALEM

- The New Jerusalem is the place where resurrected saints will live, however, we will reign on the Millennial earth with governmental responsibilities.
- The saints will easily travel from the New Jerusalem to the Millennial earth just as angels now travel from heaven to earth.
- These truths are given to strengthen us so we resist temptation and endure persecution.
   Whatever it costs, living with Jesus in the New Jerusalem is worth it.
- The centerpiece of God's purpose is to bring heaven and earth together (Eph. 1:9-10), establishing His kingdom rule over all the earth.



Jesus will rule the earth with the natural processes not suspended, yet enhanced by the Spirit's supernatural dimension (like when Jesus appeared after the resurrection)

– Jn.20:12, Acts 1 -

#### JESUS' THRONE OF GLORY

- At the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming, Jesus will establish His **Throne of Glory** on earth in Jerusalem (Mt.25:31-32, Jer.3:17). But His Throne of Glory will be connected to the Holy of Holies in the Millenniel Temple (Ez.43:4-7)
- So, does Jesus have one Throne or two? Is it on the Millennial earth or in the New Jerusalem?
- The suggested answer is
   YES...both on earth and in Heaven.



ONE THRONE WITH 2
EXPRESSIONS

#### NEW JERUSALEM WILL DESCEND

- The New Jerusalem will descend to a place above Millenial Jerusalem on Mt. Zion. It will be a vast high city that connects with earth. (see Is. 4:3-6)
- Four reasons to believe the New Jerusalem is close to Millennial earth <u>but not yet on it</u>:
- 1. Millennial Jerusalem is 10 miles square, the New Jerusalem is 1,380 miles cubed. (Ez.48:30-35, 45:5, 48:15-19)
- 2. Kings of Millennial earth come into the New Jerusalem. (Rev.21:24-26)
- 3. The leaves in the New Jerusalem are for the healing of the earthly nations. So people on earth have access to them (Rev.22:2)
- 4. Angels guard the entry to the City to keep sinners out (so it must connect to earth) (Rev.21:12,27;22:14-15).




#### JERUSALEM IN THE SKY-

Guarded by angels – just as they guarded the entrance to the Garden of Eden after Adam sinned (Gen.3:22-24)



#### THE NEW JERUSALEM WILL DESCEND IN 2 STAGES

- First, it will descend at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming to begin the Millennium (Rev.21:10)
- Second, after the Millennial earth is cleansed with fire to become the New Earth, the New Jerusalem will be on the (huge) New Earth in the age to come.
- By understanding the structure of Rev. 21-22 we can see the 2 descents of the New Jerusalem. We know the events of Rev. 21:9-22:5 refer to the Millennium because the nature of what is described includes the eternal and temporal realms together.
- The same angel showed John the Bride in Rev.21:9-10 and the harlot Babylon in Rev. 17:1-3. Both are parallel visions that are clearly parenthetical (not in chronological order).
- The descent of New Jerusalem in 21:2 is the last event in the final chronological section.



#### JOHN'S DESCRIPTION OF THE HOLY CITY

#### External View - Holy of Holies

- Design: Cube (21:16) like Holy of Holies
- Adornment: 8 of the precious stones (21:19-20) that were on high priest's breastplate (signifying nearness to God)
- Glory: filled with Shekinah glory as in the Temple

   brilliance of ancient jasper
   Chr.5-7, Rev.21:11, 23; 22:5)
- Construction: (Ch 21) has 12 gates on 4 walls, 12 foundations, and streets of gold. Gates may be spaced evenly about every 400 miles (1,380).
- Size: Walls are 1380 miles in length, width, height.
   Walls are 216 feet thick.

#### **Internal View – Garden of Eden**

- John describes the ultimate Garden of Eden the beauty (21:22-27) and its life with face-to-face communion with God (22:1-5)
- A worshipping city with no temple, a governmental city with God's throne, a servant City that works, and a Holy City devoid of sin.
- Life in the city, the pure river of the Water of Life, and the Tree of Life with 12 kinds of fruit and healing leaves all point to Eden. There will be no curse. (Ch. 22)
- The saints will serve God in a face-to-face relationship with holiness (22:3-5). God's light will impart power, wisdom and holiness to those ruling with Him. The saints will not be idle, but will be administering His government with authority over a billion galaxies

But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God's throne; nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.

JERUSALEM

 Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the LORD's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it. They saw it (New Jerusalem connected to the Millennial Jerusalem), and so they marveled; They were <u>troubled</u>, they <u>hastened away</u>. Fear took hold of them there, and pain, as of a woman in birth pangs...So we have seen In the city of the LORD of hosts, In the city of our God: God will establish it forever. Selah. 

## HOW REVELATION ENDS...

### FINALLY, WHAT SHOULD BE OUR RESPONSE TO THE BOOK OF THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST?

**JESUS** will not begin to release the seal judgments until the bowls of prayer are full.(Rev.5:8)

**DAVID** prophesied of a generation that would release God's judgments on the nations through worship and prayer, which is an honor for all the saints (Ps.149:6-9)

**ISAIAH** prophesied of the generation that would continue in 24/7 prayer until Jerusalem is established as a praise in all the earth at the time of Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming (Is.62:6-7)

**JEREMIAH** prophesied about the place of prayer in the last generation (31:7, 51:8)

**ZECHARIAH** prophesied about the place of prayer in the last generation (8:21-22, 10:1,12:10, 13:9)


**JESUS** prophesied there would be a generation that would release end-time judgment through 24/7 prayer (Lk.18:7-8)
