



## A Time for Everything

(Ecclesiastes 3:1-8)

<sup>1</sup> For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. <sup>2</sup> A time to be born and a time to die. A time to plant and a time to harvest. <sup>3</sup> A time to kill and a time to heal. A time to tear down and a time to build up. <sup>4</sup> A time to cry and a time to laugh. A time to grieve and a time to dance. 5 A time to scatter stones and a time to gather stones. A time to embrace and a time to turn away. <sup>6</sup>A time to search and a time to quit searching. A time to keep and a time to throw away. <sup>7</sup> A time to tear and a time to mend. A time to be quiet and a time to speak. 8 A time to love and a time to hate. A time for war and a time for peace.

The writer of Ecclesiastes reminds us, "For everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven" (3:1). Change is seldom easy, but when we know God is directing those seasonal shifts in our lives we can rest and abide in His purposes. This is such a time. After much prayer and soul searching, I believe the Lord is leading me into a new ministry season. As I announced last week, I have accepted a call to College Baptist Church in Big Spring, TX and respectfully have submitted my resignation as pastor of Central Baptist Church.

In 2018, Shawn and I packed up a U-Haul truck and drove across Texas in hopes of leading Central Baptist Church from a congregation in decline to a revitalized family of growing disciples. God has been good to us, because God is always good.

He has increased our weekly worship attendance and grown our ministry budget. We have added staff members and reorganized our ministry teams and committees to a point that I believe Central is healthier and trending upward.

I am grateful for the loving kindness you have shown to me and to Shawn over the years and I am sure of this: He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus (Philippians 1:6).

I trust you understand this decision has been bathed in prayer for months. A desire of my heart and Shawn's has been to be positioned for greater influence in the lives of our grandchildren and we prayed God's will to be done in that regard. Over the past few years opportunities have presented themselves toward that reality, but each time we declined because we didn't feel it was God's timing.

When the Lord opened this door we sensed His leading and liberty, but it doesn't make the transition less painful. Our hearts are torn and pulled in two directions. On the one hand we grieve because we love you, and on the other hand we look with hope-filled optimism toward a new chapter in God's plan and His timing.

Thank you again for your love and support. May God richly bless you as you serve Him.






