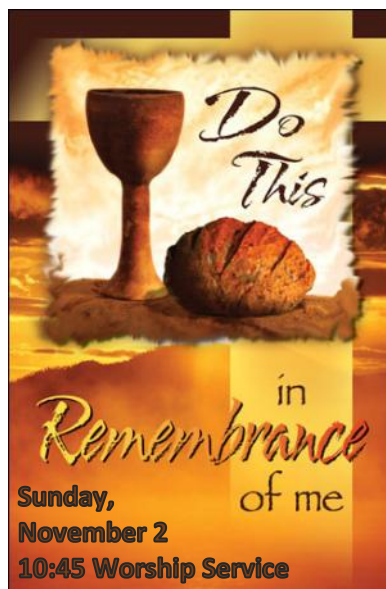

NOVEMBER WOO MEETING –

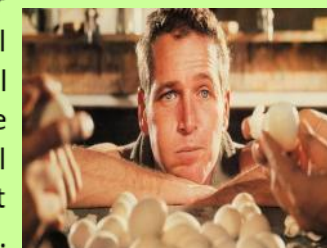
