KEY QUESTION

Who can do what Jesus says?

BOTTOM LINE

I can do what Jesus says.

BASIC TRUTH

Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

STORY FOCUS

Great Commission

Matthew 28:19-20; Romans 15:14 Jesus tells His friends, the disciples, to teach everyone to do what Jesus says.

ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Milk
- Plate
- Food coloring (various colors)
- Dish soap
- Cotton swab

WHAT YOU DO:

- Pour a thin layer of milk onto the plate.
- Add a few drops of different colored food coloring to the milk.
- Dip the cotton swab in dish soap.
- Touch the soapy end of the cotton swab to the center of the milk and watch the colors spread.

WHAT YOU SAY:

- Look how these colors quickly spread all over the milk! This reminds me of what we learned about in our Bible story. Jesus said to go into all of the earth and make disciples. Jesus asks us to go and tell others about Him. And just like these colors spread, the Good News about Jesus is supposed to spread too! So, you can do what Jesus says and go tell others about Him. Bottom Line - Who can do what Jesus says? I can do what Jesus says."
