WITH GOD ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE

"If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes" (Mark 9:23). The words of Jesus still ring true today for anyone who will believe.

What Things Are Possible?

With God you can rise above and be healed of a broken heart, addictions, sicknesses, sin, poverty, relationships, tragedies – and all other storms that are common to mankind. This is the reason Jesus left His place in heaven to be born as a man.

Jesus said, "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed" (Luke 4:18).

What About God's Will?

A man with leprosy came to Jesus one day and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."

Then Jesus put out *His* hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing;

be cleansed." Immediately his leprosy was cleansed (Lk 5:12-13)

It was the same thing over and over for more than 3 years – healing "multitudes" of people everywhere He went. Jesus was and is the will of God in person and in action.

Who Is It For?

The Word and the promises of God are available to everyone who is facing any of life's challenges!

Jesus taught all through His earthly ministry – "whoever" believes will be saved, healed, free, filled, etc.

It's Not Magic

Miracles, healings, and answers to prayer happen when someone believes God. It isn't magic, it doesn't happen if we "snap our fingers," and it's not always instantaneous. The power of God is available to all who stand in faith, and believe with their heart, not just their head. (See 2 Corinthians 4:18; 5:7; Proverbs 3:5.)

Don't Give Up

Situations can look hopeless. Pain can be almost unbearable, and emotions can seem out of control. But God is the Creator and He knows how to fix anything!

Sometimes our senses are far more developed than our faith – but we who believe walk by faith, not by sight; senses (2 Corinthians 5:7).

The Names Above All Names

The name of Jesus is above every name that is named. Pray in Jesus' name, because His name is above the names of cancer, heart problems, blood disorders, diabetes, etc.

Expectancy

A woman with a blood disorder for many years heard about Jesus coming to her town. Her faith began to rise as she heard about all the miracles among the multitudes of people. (Our faith rises as we meditate on the Scriptures that tell of His mighty works too!) She believed and said that if she could reach out and touch His garment she would be healed – and she was! Jesus said to her, "your faith has healed you." (Mark 5:25-34.)

Resist Fear and Resist Doubt

Fear and doubt will creep in when you're believing God for a miracle. Jesus said, "in the world you will have tribulation, but be of good cheer (courage) I have overcome the world" (Matt 16:33; James 4:7).

Speak the Word And Signs Will Follow!

After Jesus was raised from the dead and returned to Heaven, the disciples went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with *them* and confirming the word through the accompanying signs (Mar 16:20). That's the exact way Jesus ministry happened – everywhere He went He preached the Word and then miracles happened among the people.

You and I are imitators of Jesus and are appointed to go out into all the world and preach the Word of God. When we do, there will be miracles, healings and people being set free!
