How to Speed Up Your Manifestation

Believe it or not, you can participate in speeding up your manifestation – OR slowing it down.

A manifestation is when you see & feel what you are believing for.

In John 14:21 Jesus instructs us, "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

In Colossians 3:16 the apostle Paul instructs us "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom..."

The manifestation of what you are believing for is directly connected to what you store up in your heart and the words that you speak.

As children of God we can speak like God, "who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did," (Rom 4:17b).

Take every opportunity to **Prophesy:**

- *I call my body healed.
- *I call myself prosperous!
- *I call myself disciplined.
- *I call myself free from fear!

This illustrates the God kind of faith. God says things are so before there is physical proof that they are so. The same thing was done at creation (Genesis 1). God spoke everything into existence, and then it was so. He spoke light into existence and then four days later created a source for that light to come from (Genesis 1:3 and Genesis 1:14-19).

God has given us the power to create with faith-filled words (Proverbs 18:20-21, Mark 11:14 and Mark 11:23). If we are going to operate in God's kind of faith, we must learn to call those things that are not as though they were.

Your Word Level Matters

The measure of your Word level, is the measure that will come back to you. "For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you" Luke 6:38b.

In Mark 4:24 Jesus instructed us "Take heed what you hear. With "the same measure you use, it will be measured to you; and to you who hear, more will be given."

In Colossians 3:16 the apostle Paul instructed about how we can speed up our manifestation: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and

admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord."

If your Word level is low, you can slow down or block your manifestation.

Give Attention to the WORD

According to **Proverbs 4:20-23**, the Lord instructs us "give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.

Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life."

If you want to speed up your manifestation, you can't be half-hearted or passive.

The "Easy" Way to Believe

In Matthew 9:2-6 we have a great way to believe and receive manifestations.

"Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you." And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!"

But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'?

But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house."

In other words, Jesus demonstrated that anything and everything is 'easy' for the Lord God! (He created the universe!)

We should learn to SAY when confronted with a hard problem:

*That's easy for Jesus.

*With Christ in me, it's easy.

It seems that when we think just naturally, we SAY: this is hard, or I'm sick, or I can't pay my bills.

Do Like Jesus Did

In John 5:19 Jesus told us what He did: "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner."

Essentially, believers imitate Jesus (Eph 5:1), and He does the work.

We speak TO the mountain (Mk 11:23) and He does the work.
We 'abide' in the Word (Jn 8:31-32; Jn 15:7) and He does the work.

The best way to speed up your manifestation is to remember who Jesus is – and who you are, what you have, and what you can do in Christ.
