

EQUIPMENT UPGRADE

It is great to replace the "franken-computers," the pieces and parts put together in the general shape of a computer. Thanks to a grant of \$12,488 from the Elmer H. Schmidt Christian Broadcasting Fund we were able to upgrade all three computers in the studio. These machines run the automation and file transfer systems, are used for production work, and stream and record video. Along with this we replaced our headphone distribution amplifier, monitoring equipment for our remote stations, and we purchased a **laptop** for the new general manager. We also added three large **batteries** to our solar powered system in Price, as well as a unit called a **Chargeverter**, which will allow our generator in Price to function properly. We are grateful and pray that God abundantly blesses our friends at Community Foundation of the North State which oversees the Elmer H. Schmidt Christian Broadcasting Fund! We were blessed last year to receive a \$24,000 grant from the same fund to upgrade our heating and cooling system.
