

Recommendation from your Deacons:



The Elevate 270 elevator project has been completed for initial concept design and review by the architect. Next steps are for the architect to complete technical drawings for solicitation of bids from contractors. Also, there is a construction management line performed by the architect that is included below.

The deacons recommend we approve the following to continue the process of soliciting bids from contractors. Total quotation for technical drawings and construction management below:

- a. Design Phase Service \$33,350 (permit and bid documents)
- b. Construction Phase Service \$12,150 (on-site reviews and consulting)

***Funds to be paid out of the Building Fund line item in our budget.

This will be presented in a called conference to the church body for a vote after the morning service on Sunday, August 31st, 2025.


