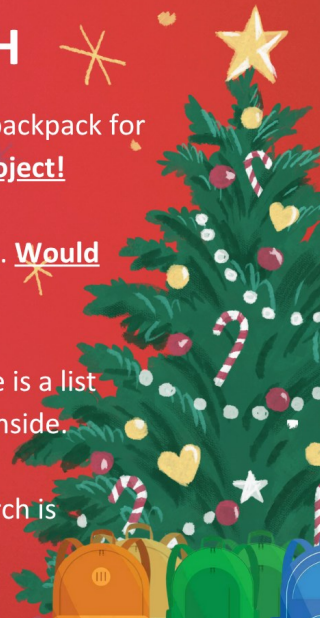
CHRISTMAS OUTREACH
