# Policies & Procedures (Pertaining to mission trips through iProjects)

Our goal is to make sure that each iProjects mission trip is a valuable and positive experience for all participants. The following policies and procedures are meant to help unite and prepare each team so that it can have the greatest possible impact.

- All participates must fill in an official iProjects application form and submit it for approval.
- Recommended vaccine shots from the Health Centre are required for any person participating on an iProjects mission trip unless a signed waiver has been provided.
- Team meetings will be facilitated online and attendance at these meetings is mandatory. The exact dates and times of meetings will be scheduled by Alan Garrett at a time that is convenient for everyone. It is vital to have a unified and focused team for any successful mission trip.
- Team members will be informed immediately in the unlikely event that pricing for the mission trip should increase. iProjects will do everything possible to keep the mission trip affordable and ensure the safety and quality of experience for all trip participants.
- Each member is responsible to raise the suggested donation amount or greater or pay their own trip costs. Tax receipts will be issued for third person donations (donors other than you). Tax receipts are available for the participants' donations as long as they fall within CRA guidelines.
- Each member must provide a valid passport and travel documents required for the trip. Passports must have a minimum of 6 months of eligibility left on them. A copy of the information page of the passport is required with the completed application form.
- No Alcohol or smoking is permitted during the mission trip.
- To ensure the safety of all team members, the field coordinators (Alex and/or Jorge Cotrina) have the final say in all decisions made while the team is in Peru.

#### 1) Important Deadlines to Remember:

a) Finances:

1. \$1000 Deposit with Application – Dec 14th, 2025

2. \$1000 or \$1200 Feb 8th, 2026

c) Vaccinations Required by: Not required for Lima travel.

d) Valid Passport with at least six months remaining till renewal time

## 2) What is the Cost? Suggested Donation of either \$2000 or \$2200

Donation covers all flights, internal taxes, food, accommodations and travel while in Peru. In addition, part of the donation will be used to purchase food for distribution to those in need and construction materials.

You will be responsible for all trip medical insurance costs and personal spending money. *Please note that travel insurance is mandatory*. Transportation to Toronto Pearson Airport is not included.

#### **3) What shots should I consider?** (These are not required)

- 1 Tetanus Shot should be up to date (Within last ten years)
- 2 Hepatitis A and B (recommend Twinrix)

#### 4) Is the food and water safe?

Please be assured that every effort will be made to ensure that food is properly and safely prepared. We also only drink bottled water or water that has been filtered.

### 5) What is the accommodation like?

Accommodation still has to be determined but will be safe and secure.

#### 6) What else should I bring?

Sunscreen Toiletries Candy (kids love candy) Hand Sanitizer

Other items as recommended by your team leader.

#### 7) What Luggage can I bring?

Based on current airline policy you can carry one 50lb bag and this has been factored into the size of the donation. You are also allowed to have a backpack as a carry on. Please note that Airlines are constantly changing the rules and regulations regarding luggage; you will be updated as information becomes available.

More information will be provided during team meetings to be scheduled by the team leader.
