Missionary Trip – Oliveira Family.

Dear Prayer Partners,

Certainly, some brothers and sisters have wondered about the silence of the Oliveira Family after the missionary trip of the project **“To the Last House 2025.”**

Yes, we quieted our hearts, because so many things happened that all we could say was:

“Many, O Lord my God, are the wonders which You have done; if I would declare and speak of them, they are more than can be numbered.” (Psalm 40:5).



Our mission did not end with the trip. Since then, we have continued the project by mentoring workers along the Juruá River and the Purus River, and by closely following the new churches that are emerging as a result of this project.

During this year, we visited churches in Rio Grande do Sul, Santa Catarina, Paraná, and São Paulo, sharing testimonies of the missionary work in Amazonas, challenging people toward missions, and encouraging and giving opportunities for Christians in local churches to become involved with us in the task of reaching **to the last house**.

Now, in **March 2026**, the date for the **second phase of the missionary project “To the Last House 2026”** is approaching.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

We will begin in São Paulo at the MEAP Missionary Retreat, then fly to Manaus. From Manaus, we will travel up the Solimões River to the mouth of the Purus River, going village by village until Boca do Acre.

After that, we will enter the Envira and Tarauacá Rivers (tributaries of the Juruá River), navigating to the city of Envira, then Eirunepé, and finally, along the Juruá River, reaching Ipixuna and Cruzeiro do Sul in Acre, where the journey will conclude.
