



Position: Dad Bootcamp Medical Volunteer

Ministry Purpose: In accordance with Luke 10:1-2, the Nurse Volunteer is responsible for sharing God's Truth while caring for clients in the center. He should seek to be a role model in attitude, speech, and actions in his consistent daily walk with Jesus Christ. He should be prepared to explain the center's religious beliefs and practices if asked. And he should be prepared to educate, provide resources and assistance, consistent with the center's Statement of Faith and Mission Statement, to all those who inquire.

Licensure/certification: Currently licensed as a RN, LPN, or NP in the State of Georgia

Primary Qualifications:

Consistent with the above-described ministry requirements, the following constitute the major responsibilities of the volunteer nurse:

- Is a committed Christian who demonstrates a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior
- Demonstrates strong leadership by maintaining personal, professional, spiritual balance and health, encouraging/enabling others to do so
- Has knowledge of pro-life issues, pregnancy, parenting and community resources
- Is willing to relate to and respect all clients equally, without bias
- Exhibits a sincere desire to minister to men and families involved in an unplanned pregnancy
- Committed to serve as a medical volunteer for at least 1 (one) year
- Is willing to share the good news of the Gospel in love and compassion for the lost
- Committed to sexual purity, abstinent if single, and faithful to their spouse if married
- Is willing to take ownership and responsibility for the PPS ministry as an extension of the Body of Christ in our community
- Is willing to allow their life to be transformed by the Lord as they serve at PPS

General Qualifications:

- Exhibits a strong commitment and dedication to the sanctity of all human life
- Faithfully attends church and is in fellowship with other believers
- Fully agrees with the PPS Mission Statement, Statement of Principle, Statement of Faith, and all Policies and Procedures set forth by the Board of Directors of PPS
- Respects and complies with all confidentiality policies of PPS and state and federal laws concerning confidentiality
- Carries out all job responsibilities under the general supervision of the Client Services Manager
- Demonstrates strong interpersonal and team unity skills
- Is at least 21 years of age



Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead/teach Dad Bootcamp curriculum; to be held quarterly
- Provides holistic care to clients relating to their physical, spiritual, and emotional health to equip fathers with the basic skills and confidence needed to overcome challenges they may face
- Discusses medically accurate information regarding pregnancy, labor & delivery, newborn care, etc.
- Deliver guidance in a safe, supportive environment where fathers can deal with their fears and concerns
- Maintain an appropriate standard of care established by experts in the field (such as CDC, ACOG, AAPLOG, etc.)
- Comply with state and professional continuing education requirements
