

Jesus is the **Person** of the Good Nevvs

"Concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh and was declared to be the Son of God in power"

(1:3-4)

Descended from David



- Demonstrates his human nature
- "According to the Flesh"
 - Flesh (sarx), body, flesh, skin.
 - Prophecy had stated that the Messiah would come from the line of David

Son of God



- In the Old Testament this was a Jewish title pointing to the Messiah.
- In the New Testament this becomes an incarnational title applied to Jesus Christ.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

(Jn 3:16, ESV)

John 1:1, 14



"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God ... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth." (ESV)

Philippians 2:5-11



"Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth ... and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord." (ESV)

Jesus is the **Provision** of the Good News

"Declared to be the Son of God in power ... by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord" (1:4)



Declared (horidzo)



- Confirmed, established, made definite.
 - His identity was established and confirmed with power through his resurrection from the dead.

Hebrews 2:14-15



"Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery."

1 Corinthians 15:55-56



"Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?' The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (ESV)

Revelation 1:17-18



"Fear not, I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades." (ESV)

Jesus Christ Our Lord (kurios)



Owner, Master, Boss

- Paul's title of choice throughout Romans
- In the O.T., the word LORD replaced the most sacred, unpronounceable name of God.
- Used 6150 times in the O.T. in place of the proper name Yahweh

Romans 10:9, 13



"If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved ... For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." (ESV)

Jesus Christ, Our Lord



Christ's provision is only applied when you receive him, and you make him Lord—acknowledging him as your owner in every sense of the word, and you are obedient to him and his commands.
