For them he had some promise, but after what they had witnessed in those last hours, had convinced them he was nothing. Another failure! Yet, the robe and the crown were setting on the head of a King. A King like no other! Who was on a mission like no other! Jesus our Lord! He is like no other!

This coming Thursday evening we are gathering for communion. Jesus in the garden is our theme. There is a lot on his mind on that night. He is about to do what none of us can do. He is going to pay the price of our guilt. He is going to endure our shame. I pray we come into that place with hearts seeking to be moved. Love is on display!

Sunday is Easter. No more wandering in the desert. It all will change on Sunday. What does the Resurrection mean? Is it only about Jesus coming back from the grave? Maybe there is more to it! What does it mean for us? Oh, so many questions. We'll talk more on Sunday. Have a great week!
