

Hi Everyone!

I have been sharing our need for Sunday School teachers for a few weeks and we thought it might be helpful to describe what teaching Sunday School at Community looks like!

Sunday School starts at 10am. Each class has 2 teachers (and some classes have helpers as well.) The teachers take turns teaching so that no one has to commit to every week. Some teams rotate every other week, some every other month, and some just work together to pick weeks that work for them. It is up to you! We usually have some teachers with experience and many with little or no teaching experience.

We try to make the Sunday School lesson easy for you to teach, so you can focus on building connections with the kids and learning about the Bible together. I put the supplies in a bag and folder, labeled with the date for the lesson, in your classroom so you can come in, check it out, and get right to it! There is a binder in the room with all of the lessons and a copy for each of the teachers to take home.

For the preschool age kids, a lesson is usually a short puppet skit, a Bible story, prayer, and a little craft. For the Elementary kids, there is a Bible lesson, discussion, hands on activity and prayer time.

Some of the "perks" Sunday School teachers have shared with us are:

- Sunday School teachers learn along with the kids.
- Meeting great kids and families is a great perk!
- Sunday School teachers are "prayed up" by some special people in our church.
- A guaranteed 40 minutes to connect with others from church, spend time in God's word, pray, and learn.
- Who doesn't want to have kids wave at them at church?
- This is a low stress way to positively impact the faith journey of other people, and yourself.

- PreK- 2 teachers and 1 helper
- Kindergarten-1 more teacher
- 2nd grade-1 more teacher
- 3rd grade-1 more teacher

For Midweek, we'll need some "Midweek Grown Ups" to learn and have fun with us.
