## Hi Everyone!

I was thinking about how quickly summer is moving along and how it feels like just yesterday we were having fun at VBS together. Now we're more than halfway through summer and the days are getting shorter. If you're like me and wanting to bask a bit in the truth that Jesus is the LIGHT, you might enjoy some the activities below. We'll make the most of these cozy summer nights before back-to-school time catches up to us.

## Shadow Puppets:

- All you need is to shine a flashlight on a sheet or blank wall and put your hands in between! Change the shape of your hands to make various shapes. Can you make a heart? A cross? Different animals?
- When you run out of cool ways to shape your hands, try your feet!
- Grab some toys and see what kinds of shadows those make. It can be fun to trace the shadow on a piece of white paper as well if you set a toy between the flashlight and the paper.
- It can be super fun with paper shapes too!

## Homemade Constellations:

- Draw a simple shape on a notecard. Use a pencil to poke little holes all along your shape.
- Shine a flashlight through the card and take a look at your design, glowing on the wall.
- Now that you've seen how it works, make another one!

## Flashlight Tag:

- An old favorite- the tagger shines the light at the other players. If you get caught by the flashlight, you're out.
- A fun alternative is freeze tag- if the light shines on you, you are frozen until another player can tag you to set you free.

## Flashlight Limbo:

- Don't break the beam! Set the flashlight on a table and limbo under the light.
- How low can you go? Can you limbo low enough to get below the light? Can you jump over it?
