As I mentioned in my article last week, I've been doing a lot of reading since Mid-Week ended. That's a big part of what I do to prepare for the coming year of Discipleship ministry at Community. Every year at this time, I usually end up going to a few graduation parties, and my gift of choice for graduates is a daily devotional. I have a personal favorite I've been gifting to kids (and adults) for years (see below). So, I thought it might be helpful to share some of my recommendations for daily devotionals. Here are a few to consider.

#### My Utmost for His Highest – Oswald Chambers

This daily devotional is considered a classic among Christian devotionals. And Chambers' words are still incredibly poignant for today. There are a couple of different options with this devotional. Since it was written almost 100 years ago, you have the option to buy the original or an updated language version. In this case, I actually prefer his original wording. It's not hard to understand, and his choice of words definitely has a fullness that some of the updated language misses. But both versions are excellent.

#### Streams in the Desert - L. B. Cowman updated version by James Reimann

This daily devotional focuses on the hardships of life and where God's life-giving "streams" can be found. There have been many times in my life when I've read Cowman's words, and been stunned by how specifically they have related to my own life. Once again, this was first published nearly 100 years ago, and in this instance, I actually prefer the updated language version. Reimann did a phenomenal job of updated Cowman's language. This is the devotional I gift to people most often. God uses it in powerful ways.

#### Hearing God Through the Year - Dallas Willard

This is a daily devotional with excerpts from Willard's outstanding book, "Hearing God." In fact, this little daily devotional was how I first encountered "Hearing God." I loved it so much that I bought the full book! The daily devotional takes short sections of the book and couples them with Bible verses and prayer. These are short little devotionals and would work well for people who are short on time.

I hope this gives you a place to start if you've been looking for something to inspire a bit of daily time with God. It's always a blessing!
