I know I say this every year, but I can't believe that this week marks the beginning of September already! The month of August just flew by!

I'd like to talk a bit about an upcoming workshop I'll be hosting on Wednesday, September 22 from 6-8pm. At this workshop, I'll be teaching about the enneagram, which is a tool we can use to understand how we function and grow in our spiritual walks with Christ. There is a lot of misinformation floating around out there about the enneagram, and I have felt strongly compelled to teach the truth about it to any adults who might be interested. This is a singular workshop. I'll not be teaching on this again during Mid-Week, and I will not be offering any small group studies about it, mostly because there are more important things to teach about! The enneagram is a tool and only a tool. We use it in much the same way we might use the Myers-Briggs personality test or the Clifton Strengths Finder or even one of many temperaments tests you can find. These things are tools, just like a hammer is a tool. When we use tools in the proper way, they serve us. We do not serve them. And tools in and of themselves have no power. They only become useful when people who know how to use them use them appropriately. The same is true of the enneagram, and I'll unpack that more at the workshop. This is a free workshop and open to any adult. An RSVP is appreciated but not required. Please let me know if you have any questions!
