MAIN IDEA

FOSTER A FULLER RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS

TALK ABOUT IT

- How does the goal of friendship with Jesus change the way we view spiritual disciplines?
- Read Psalm 1:1-3 together. What words or images stand out to you from this passage?
- Psalm 1 doesn't promise fewer storms—it promises deeper roots. Why is that distinction important?
- Have you ever experienced a time when Scripture changed your thinking, attitude, or direction? What happened?
- Why do you think devotion to Scripture is often the hardest discipline to stay consistent with?
- The sermon talked about the difference between soul (feelings) & spirit (truth). Can you think of a time when your feelings and God's truth were in tension?
- Why is it dangerous to let feelings lead without the correction of God's Word?
- How is the Bible like a mirror for the soul rather than a self-help manual?
- What's the danger of looking into the mirror of Scripture but walking away unchanged?
- Psalm 1 contrasts duty and delight. Why do you think delight not discipline alone is key to spiritual growth?
- How does reading the Bible with the goal of knowing Jesus differ from reading it out of duty or habit?
- Jesus said we can study Scripture and still miss Him. How does that happen?
- Jesus revealed Himself through the Scriptures. What does that tell us about where and how we meet Jesus today?
- You don't drift into closeness. You decide it." How does that statement challenge or encourage you?
- How does Scripture help center you when life feels busy, uncertain, or overwhelming?
- What voices (media, culture, emotions, others) compete with God's Word for influence in your life?
- Psalm 119:105 says God's Word gives light for the next step, not the whole journey. Where do you need clarity for just the next faithful step?
- What obstacles keep you from consistently engaging the Bible?
- Which of the three ideas—power, closeness, or centering—do you most need right now?
