Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- What do you think it would be like to be a king or a queen?
- How is Jesus different from other kings in the world?
- What does Jesus rule over as King?
- What are some ways our family can honor Jesus as King in our lives?



A Royal Meal

Choose to have a special family dinner one night this week and make it fancy! As a family, plan the meal together. What is something that everyone will enjoy and that also feels more special than an everyday meal? Consider how to set the table for the meal—use a nice tablecloth, napkins, your fanciest dishes, etc. You may want to have special music and mood lighting.

Each person in the family can participate by helping with cooking, setting the table, choosing music, or cleaning up after the meal.

Before the meal, family members can put on their fanciest clothes. Consider taking a family selfie to capture the moment!

At your meal, talk about what it would be like to live life as a royal. Then contrast it with the life we see Jesus living when He was on earth. Discuss: What stands out to you about how Jesus chose to live, even though He is King of everything?



Crown the King

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem, all the people shouted, "Hosanna," which roughly means "save us now." As a family, think through what it means that Jesus, the King, saves us from our sins and offers us new life in Him.

Gather some paper and scissors, and then go online to find simple ways to make a paper crown. Together, make a crown and then decorate it any way you like. After the crown is made, take turns wearing it as you discuss the following: Jesus is King! What does that mean to you? How can our family follow King Jesus today? Tomorrow? How has King Jesus saved you? Can you think of a specific time when God stepped in to save our family?

Jesus wants everyone to know He is King. Take some time to think about people your family knows who don't yet know that Jesus saves and that He is King. Pray for them together and think of ways you can share this good news with them!
