TCS Summer Camp Parent FAQ

What, When, and Where?

What: TCS Summer Camp offers students a chance to step away from their everyday I ives, enjoy nature, and deepen their relationship with Jesus through various activities, worship, and community.

When & Where:

Junior High Students (Incoming 6th Graders to 8th Graders): These students will attend camp at Forest Home in Forest Falls, CA.

Camp Dates: Monday, June 16th, 2025 - Saturday, June 21st, 2025.

Camp Information Meeting Date: May 28th, 2025 | 6:30pm

High School Students (Incoming 9th Graders to Outgoing Seniors): These students will attend the CIY (Christ In Youth) camp, located at Biola University in Southern California.

Camp Dates: Monday, July 14th, 2025 - Saturday, July 19th, 2025 Camp Information Meeting Date: June 25th, 2025 | 6:30pm

Camp Information Meeting: A detailed information meeting will be held prior to departure, where we will discuss specific details like packing lists, medical needs, bus assignments, and student leader information.

Who Can Attend?

- **Eligibility:** Camp is open to all students entering 6th grade in Fall 2025 through those who are graduating high school in 2025.
- Attendance Requirement: Participation in TCS Wednesdays is not required to join us at summer camp. All students within the eligible grades are welcome.

How Much Does It Cost?

- Camp Fee: The total cost for camp is \$529 per student.
- Payment Schedule:
 - \$100 deposit due upon registration
 - Monthly Payment of \$75 per registrant is due on the 15th of each month until your balance is paid in full.
- Refund Policy
 - Deposit 1 (\$/person) is non-refundable: Under no circumstances will the initial deposit be refunded, or transferred to another camper or event. TCS utilizes deposits to plan and program events effectively. These funds are crucial for covering the initial costs associated with the preparation and execution of the event.
 - No refunds after May 15th: After this date, refunds are only possible if another camper fills the vacated spot. This policy is in place to ensure that we can maintain commitments with our camp facilities and vendors. Deposits will still be

non-refundable in the event you cancel your registration prior to May 15th and the spot is filled by another camper.

What Is Included in the Cost?

- **Transportation:** Round-trip charter bus transportation to and from the camp location.
- **Meals:** All meals are provided while at camp. Students should bring additional money for lunch during travel to and from the camp.
- **Accommodation:** Housing in cabins (Junior High) or dorms (High School) for the duration of camp.
- Activities: Access to all scheduled games, activities, and free-time options available each afternoon.
- Junior High Camp Specifics: Forest Home operates as a cashless camp. Parents will
 receive information on how to provide their students with an e-gift card for any
 purchases they wish to make during camp (optional).
- **High School Camp Specifics:** Information will be shared regarding a planned visit to a local beach.

Where Will My Student Be Housed?

- Housing Arrangements: Students will stay in cabins (Junior High) and dormitories (High School) with a maximum of 10 people per room. Each housing location will have an assigned leader responsible for overseeing the students for the week.
- Assignment: Housing assignments will be made based on biological gender and grade.
- What to Bring: A detailed packing list will be provided at your camp meeting.

Registration Process

- **Step 1:** Complete the initial registration form provided by The Crossing.
- **Step 2:** After completing the Crossing Students form, you will be redirected to fill out a camp-specific registration form for either Forest Home or CIY, which includes important details like medical information.
 - Forest Home Registration: Follow the prompts to log in or create an account.
 Complete the necessary information, including the medical form.
 - o CIY Registration: Fill out the indicated fields on the CIY registration form.
