Discuss 

Main Scriptures: Luke 10:25-37

1. In Luke 10:25-28, the man asks Jesus, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" What stands out to you about Jesus' response?
2. Pastor Jeff said, "Conduct more than closeness makes me a neighbor." How does this challenge the way we normally define a neighbor?
3. The priest and Levite both walked past the injured man in the story of the good Samaritan. What excuses do we make today for avoiding people in need?
4. Pastor Jeff said, "Perhaps our encounters with people aren't by chance but by providence." How might that change the way you look at daily interactions?
5. The Samaritan was willing to give time, money, and ongoing care (vv. 34-55). What does this teach us about the cost of loving others?
6. Pastor Jeff said, "A neighbor lives out their obligation—to love." How can we live out Romans 13:8 ("owe nothing but love") in practical ways this week?
