## **SESSION SUMMARY**

- Since it's important to seek God in community, what steps can our family take to seek God together? Are we seeking Him in community with other believers? What steps can we take to seek God with the people in our church?

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE**

Choose one of the ways to worship God as Creator from the first question. Plan a night this week to worship God together. Find ways you can make it unique and fun for your family, whether it's playing and singing worship songs together, going for a hike and sharing about all the beauty you see in God's creation, or sharing a meal together and thanking God for the way He provides food for us to eat.
