"OUT INTO THE DEEP"

Luke 5: 1-11

Thesis: Jesus was at the Lake of Gennesaret, the Sea of Galilee. It is not a large body of water but it is beautiful. There are rolling hills down to a narrow beach. He was teaching a large crowd, then came the well-known miracle of the great catch of fish. He used this to teach his disciples about the Lordship of Jesus Christ and His call to serve. Today we learn about going out into the deep as broken men with broken tools. How can God use broken things to make 2026 a "Year of Opportunity?"

I. Broken Nets (v. 6)

- A. "... their nets began to break"
- B. A miracle took place
- C. This miracle demonstrated God's power

II. Broken Men (v. 8)

- A. "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man."
- B. Peter realizes his is in the Lord's presence
- C. He needed to repent—do you?

III. Broken Partnerships (v. 10)

- A. "... James and John, ... Simon's partners"
- B. Simon had great business possibilities
- C. They left their boats and fully surrendered

Life Application: This is a beautiful picture of full surrender and sacrifice of self to service to the Lord. They realized what they had to leave to fully surrender to Him. What must you leave to surrender your life to God so that you could really become a fisher of men? What must you leave to allow God to use you as His instrument to make 2026 a "Year of Opportunity?"


