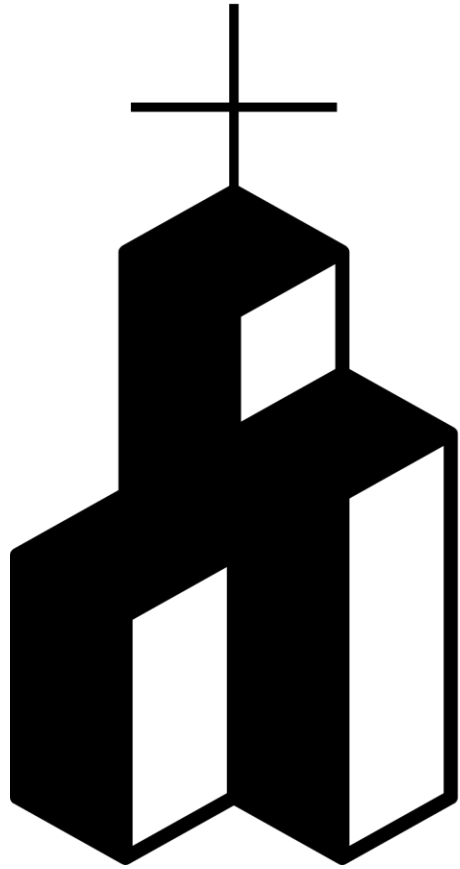

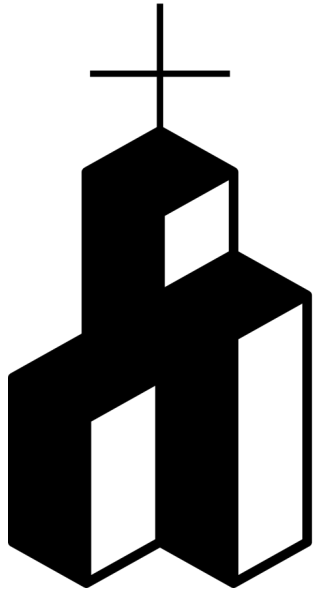

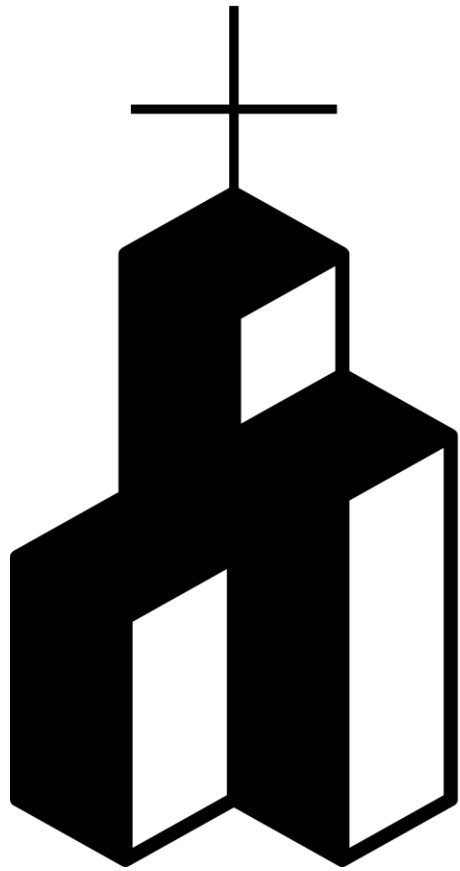

Judges 2:16-19

¹⁷ Yet they did not listen to their judges, for they whored after other gods and bowed down to them. They soon turned aside from the way in which their fathers had walked, who had obeyed the commandments of the LORD, and they did not do so.

Judges 2:16-19

¹⁸ Whenever the LORD raised up judges for them, the LORD was with the judge, and he saved them from the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge. For the LORD was moved to pity by their groaning because of those who afflicted and oppressed them.

¹⁹ But whenever the judge died, they turned back and were more corrupt than their fathers, going after other gods, serving them and bowing down to them. They did not drop any of their practices or their stubborn ways.

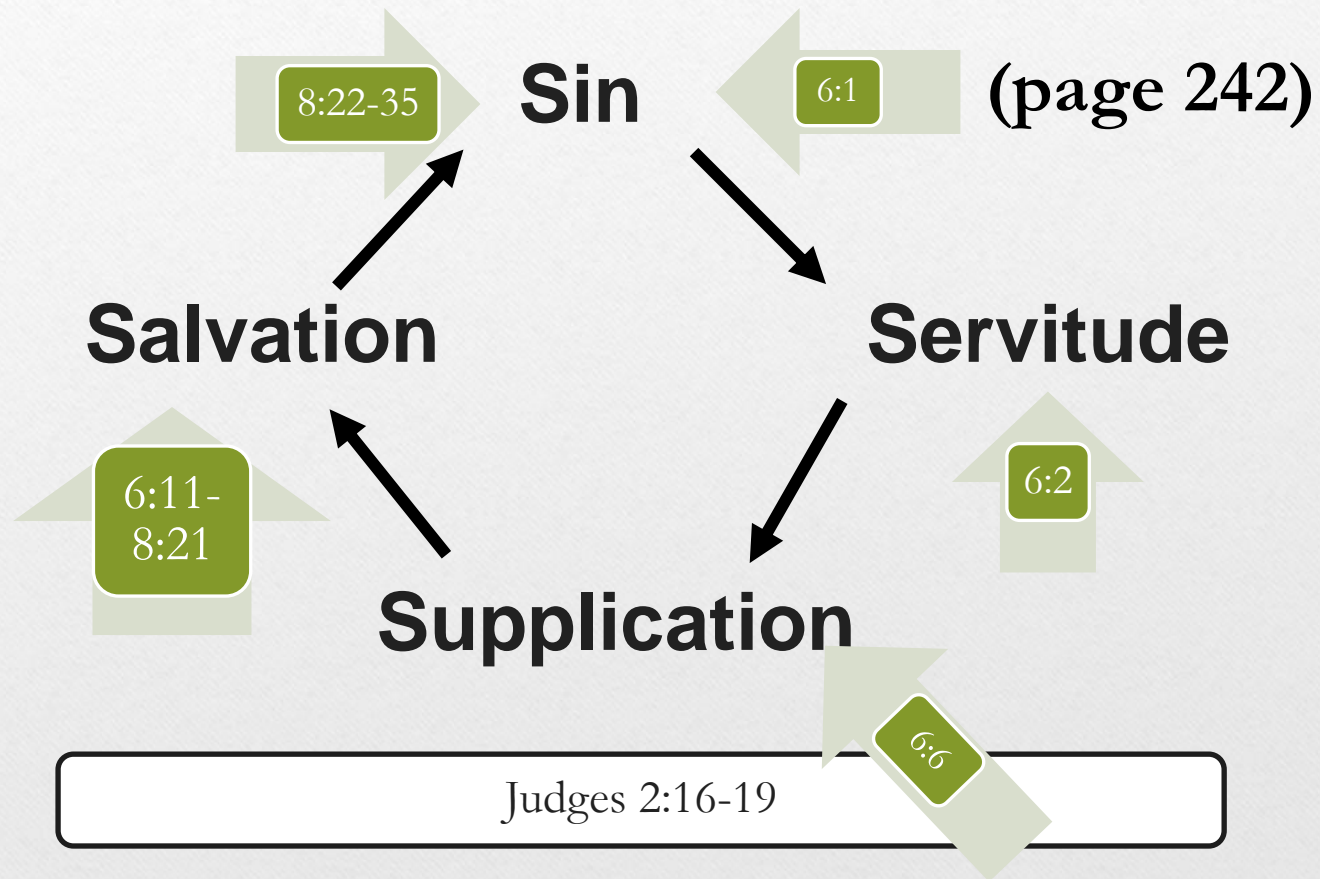

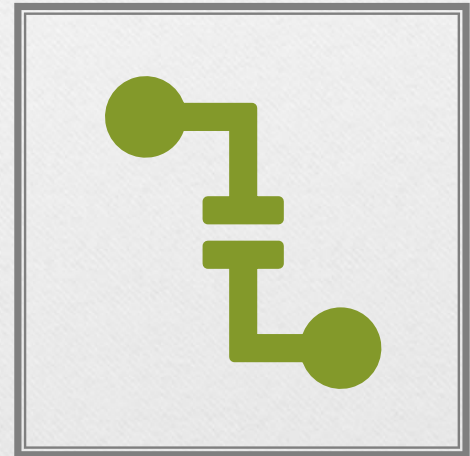

Contributions to the Cycle.

Judges 21:25 (261)

- In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.

HOW TO BREAK THE CYCLE:

- Find the perfect leader.
- Follow Him completely.
- Pass on what you have received to the next generation.

Find the perfect leader.

Jesus the Perfect Leader

John 14:6 (1070)

- Jesus said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Jesus the Perfect Leader

Acts 4:12 (1084)

- And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

Jesus the Perfect Leader

1 Timothy 2:5 (1177)

- For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,

Jesus the Perfect Leader

John 10:9 (1065)

- I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

Jesus the Perfect Leader

John 3:36 (1056)

- Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

Follow Jesus Completely

Luke 9:23 (1030)

- And he said to all, “If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.”

Follow Jesus Completely

Matthew 11:28-29 (970)

- Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Follow Jesus Completely

Romans 10:9 (1124)

- Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

have received to the
next generation.

Teach the Next Generation

2 Timothy 2:1-2 (1181)

- You then, my child, be strengthened by the grace that is in Christ Jesus, ² and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also.

Teach the Next Generation

1 Corinthians 11:1 (1138)

- Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.

Teach the Next Generation

1 Corinthians 4:15-16 (1133)

- ¹⁵ For though you have countless guides in Christ, you do not have many fathers. For I became your father in Christ Jesus through the gospel. ¹⁶ I urge you, then, be imitators of me.

Application from the book of Judges:

- Break the cycle of sin by finding the perfect leader, following Him completely, and passing along what you have received from Him to the next generation.
